As a member of a multi-disciplinary team, the RN assumes a leadership role and provides consultation and program planning to assist in promoting the health, personal, educational, social, and vocational development of people with varying abilities. The Registered Nurse also advocates on behalf of people with varying abilities and maybe a liaison with other agencies and the Department of Community Services.

Responsibilities

- 1. The Registered Nurse, Float Pool provides direct nursing care to a wide variety of adult clients requiring continuous 24-hour medical and nursing treatment using a problem-solving approach and by the standards, guidelines, and scope of professional nursing practice to facilitate individualized nursing care to the clients of Breton Ability Centre
- 2. The Registered Nurse, Float Pool facilities, implements, and modifies client and family education based on the needs of the individual client
- 3. As the team lead(Responsibility Nurse), the Registered Nurse, Float Pool assumes accountability for the standard of care delivered toward determining and achieving client goals
- 4. Advocates for the client to ensure safe, competent, and ethical nursing care

The ideal candidate has:

- Graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing
- Must have a current active practicing license with the College of Registered Nurses of Nova Scotia
- Experience working with people with varying abilities (intellectual, mental health, physical) and with complex needs
- Must be current in all mandatory education(i.e., CPR, First Aid, Low Arousal, Emergency Plan and WHMIS)
- Must have or be willing to take the "Low Arousal Training" course at the earliest date;
- Must be comfortable working in a team environment and actively contributing to a multidisciplinary team;
- Must be committed to the development of people with varying abilities and fostering opportunities for independence for each person;
- Must have excellent problem-solving skills, is an excellent communicator and take the initiative to address issues and concerns, as they arise;
- Have excellent assessment skills and apply the nursing process in assessing, planning, and evaluating clinical interventions as required for residents;
- Must have a clear criminal record check and a valid driver's license.
